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[PROPOSED] ORDER

This matter coming before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification, and the Court finding that Plaintiffs have satisfied the requirements of California Code of Civil Procedure § 382, it is hereby ordered that Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification is <u>GRANTED</u>. Accordingly, the Court Orders as follows:

1. The Court GRANTS Plaintiffs' request to certify with respect to their claims for violations of the California Constitution and money had and received, a Class defined as follows:

All San Diego Public Utility Department ("SDPUD") customers who paid bills for wastewater services provided to a residential or commercial/industrial account at an address within the City of San Diego and not subject to IWCP permitting, on or after July 1, 2014 and until the date the Class is certified by the Court, excluding Defendant and Defendant's officers, directors, employees, agents, and affiliates, and the Court and its staff.

- 2. The Court hereby appoints Plaintiffs Barry Allred and Brad Penley as the class representatives.
- 3. The Court hereby appoints the Law Offices of Ronald A. Marron, the Elliot Law Office, PC, and its individual attorneys as Class Counsel for the Class defined above. Class Counsel shall have the sole authority to perform or delegate as appropriate the following tasks on behalf of the certified Classes defined above:
 - a) Conduct settlement negotiations with Defendant and if there is a settlement, propose a claims protocol and plan of allocation;
 - b) Enter into stipulations and/or agreements with opposing counsel as necessary for the conduct of the litigation;
 - c) Determine and present (in briefs, oral argument, or such other fashion as may be appropriate, personally or by a designee) to the Court and opposing parties the position of the Plaintiffs and the Class on all matters arising during pretrial proceedings and at trial;
 - d) Coordinate and conduct discovery on behalf of Plaintiffs and the Class consistent with the requirements of the California Rules;
 - e) Allocate the distribution of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of expenses ordered by the

2	f)	Perform such other duties as may be incidental to the proper coordination of pretrial and	
3		trial activities authorized by further order of this Court.	
4	4.	The Court hereby retains jurisdiction over the claims of the certified Class for all	
5	purposes, including settlement approval.
